## EXPLANATION OF DONATIONS TO

### THE GARDEN CLUBS OF ILLINOIS, INC. FUNDS 2022-2023

*Note: Donations sent directly to Lincoln Memorial Garden, local scholarship funds, Nature Conservancy, etc. are not GCI donations. Membership in the Lincoln Memorial Garden Foundation sent directly to Springfield - should **not** be listed on this form.*

- A. GCI PRESIDENT'S PROJECT – 2022-2023 – Supports the GCI President's project for 2-year term.
- B. STATE FLOWER SHOW – Fundraising will be continuous to insure sufficient funds will be available for State Flower Show. The next State show is scheduled for 2022 at the Chicago Botanic Gardens.
- C. SCHOLARSHIP - Scholarships for students in any horticulture-related field at any Illinois college or university. Funds are derived from donations to the Scholarship Fund, Illinois Books of Honor and Remembrance, Illinois Life Membership and interest on investments of the Rhoda Evans Fund.
- D. GCI SCHOOLS / CONFERENCES / SYMPOSIUMS – Donations will be used to secure speakers for the GCI schools, conferences and symposiums. All members have the opportunity to further their education by attending these schools, conferences and symposiums.
- E. GCI GRANTS – All Garden Clubs are eligible for grants for qualified activities.
- BLUE STAR MEMORIAL MARKERS - Donations are used to help clubs defray the cost of installing and maintaining the markers, which honor those who have served, are serving and will serve in our military. The markers are available through National Garden Clubs, Inc.
- GARDEN THERAPY – Donations are used to initiate and maintain garden therapy programs in hospitals, schools and other institutional settings.
- NGC PROJECTS - Check the NGC Web Site ([www.gardenclub.org](http://www.gardenclub.org)) for a current listing.
- HISTORIC PRESERVATION - Donations are made to defray costs of restoration or maintenance of gardens at historical sites.
- WORLD GARDENING – Donations are used to provide aid for areas devastated by natural disasters.
- ROADSIDE OPERATIONS AND WILDFLOWERS – Funds are used to help clubs defray the cost of wildflowers and roadside plantings in their communities.
- F. YOUTH ACTIVITIES - Donations are used to fund programs for Youth Gardeners. Disbursements for special projects are recommended to the Board of Directors by the Youth Activities Chairman and the Finance Committee.
- G. ILLINOIS BOOK OF HONOR – Donations of at least \$10 per name to honor any **living person** are used for the Scholarship Fund and the Illinois Headquarters Special Fund. The names are recorded in a leather-bound book kept at the GCI State Office and mentioned in *GardenGlories*.
- H. ILLINOIS BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE - Donations of at least \$10 per name in remembrance of any **deceased person** are used as above (G). The names are recorded in a leather-bound book and mentioned in *GardenGlories*.
- I. LINCOLN MEMORIAL GARDEN'S LANDSCAPE RESTORATION ENDOWMENT FUND – Donations are invested and the interest is used to fund landscape maintenance projects.
- J. LINCOLN MEMORIAL GARDEN'S CHILDREN'S WOODLAND GARDEN – Funds are used to enhance and expand the children's garden at the Lincoln Memorial Garden.
- K. CENTRAL REGION DIRECTOR - It is the duty of GCI to provide some funding for the Director for their term. Each of the seven states takes its turn "to provide the Central Region Director" in a predetermined order.
- L. GCI UNRESTRICTED FUND – May be used for office operations, special purchases such as furniture and technical equipment or as directed by the GCI Board.
