Donna Rouch graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in 1983 from the University of Nebraska at Omaha and a Doctor of Pharmacy in 1993 from Creighton University. Donna has served as a club and state president, a district director, and a regional awards chair. For NGC, she has chaired the Membership, Website Search, Finance, and Internal Audit committees and served on the Nominating and Communication-Print committees. She currently serves as a liaison to the state presidents and region directors and serves as Membership and Leadership Committee chairman. Donna is a Landscape Design, Gardening and Environmental School consultant, and an accredited Flower Show judge. She has achieved the 4-star designation.



Keynote Speaker, Guy Sternberg – Monday 9:00-10:00 am

The Artistic Morphology of Trees - Find the inspiration of seeing trees with a broad new perspective. Topics include the subtleties of seasons, lighting, tree features at eye level and ground level, fragrance, wildlife interactions, how to experience the full measure of great trees, and view-shed management as related to tree placement. Learn how to use the artistic features of your existing trees more effectively in the landscape and how to plan for new trees.

Guy Sternberg is the co-founder of Starhill Forest Arboretum which has developed the most comprehensive research collection of oaks in the US with approximately 250 taxa and six globally endangered species. He is a founding member of the Illinois Native Plant Society and a past president of its central chapter. He is also a life member of the International Dendrology Society, the International Society of Arboriculture, the founding president and a life member of the International Oak Society, a 60-year life member of American Forests, and an active member of many other conservation and environmental organizations.



Floral Presenter, Kim Brannan – Monday 2:00-3:00 pm

Kim Brannan AAF, with over 20 years as a founder and floral shop owner of the award-winning Stems Florist in Florissant, MO and 29 years in the commercial interiors industry, has an amazing background in both floristry, interiors, and home gardening. She is the current regional presenter for Teleflora education due to her commitment to education for all customers, shops, and the industry. Kim has been involved with the Society of American Florists for over 10 years and the American Institute of Floral Design for over 15 years.

Sunday Field Trip Options

To attend a field trip, you must be registered in the 1-day or 2-day convention package or attend as a guest of a registered attendee.



Lincoln Memorial Garden Nature Center - Sunday 1:00-3:30 pm

A living memorial to Abraham Lincoln, the garden represents the landscape he would have known growing up and living in the Midwest, containing plants native to the three states he lived in: Kentucky, Indiana, and Illinois. Designed by internationally known landscape architect Jens Jensen, the 100-acre site features six miles of trails, footbridges, a pond, eight stone council rings, and dozens of wooden benches inscribed with Lincoln quotes. New additions include two large troll sculptures created by high school students and the new Children's Woodland Garden, opening Spring 2024.

LMG has been a special state project of GCI since its planning in early 1930s and is one of the contributors for the new Children's Woodland Garden.



The Dana-Thomas House – Sunday 1:00-3:30 pm (20 maximum attendees)

Designed by Frank Lloyd Wright in 1902 for Susan Lawrence Dana, a forward-thinking so-cialite living in Springfield, Illinois. The Prairie style home is the 72nd building designed by Wright and contains the largest collection of site-specific, original Wright art glass and furniture. Wright's first blank check commission, the home has 35 rooms in the 12,000 square feet of living space which includes three main levels and 16 varying levels in all.



Illinois Governor's Mansion and Garden – Sunday 1:00-3:30 pm (40 maximum attendees)

Nestled between Springfield's brick-paved streets and the State Capitol, the Illinois Governor's Mansion is the third-oldest state governor's residence in the United States and the oldest gubernatorial residence in the Midwest. It has been home to Illinois Governors and their families since its construction in 1855. The property was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1976. In 2015, Vinci Hamp Architects was hired by former First Lady Diana Rauner to direct a \$15 million renovation funded by private donations—including extensive interior repairs and landscaping that earned the residence a LEED Silver designation from the US Green Building Council. Governor Pritzker continued these renovation efforts with an \$850,000 donation of his own in 2019.

Field Trips - Important Note

All field trips buses will leave the hotel at 1:00 pm by bus, boarding 15 minutes prior to departure. If driving directly to location, instructions will be emailed prior to tour day. Tour times are 1:30-3:00 pm. Return to hotel at 3:30 pm. Reservations are required. Must have photo ID for historic sites. The LMG tour includes walking on accessible paths, orientation in the Education Center, and preview of the new Children's Woodland Garden. Dress for the outdoors.




